**HCCA Tuition, Fees, and Miscellaneous**

**Payment Policy \* 2018 -- 2019**



**Registration Fee:** The registration fee is \$500.00 per student. The fee is **\$300.00** (\$200 discount per student) **if paid by April 13<sup>th</sup>**, **\$400.00** (\$100.00 discount per student) **if paid between April 16<sup>th</sup> and April 30<sup>th</sup>**. There is no discount available after May 1<sup>st</sup>. International student's registration is \$700 per year. Full payment of the registration fee is required at the time of enrollment.

**Required School Insurance:** Secondary school accident insurance purchase has been mandated by the Diocese of Amarillo. Please note that this is a secondary insurance. Parents are required to carry primary insurance for a student to be eligible to participate in sports. If an accident should occur, this would help with the deductible on the primary insurance. The policy provides \$25,000 medical and \$25,000 life insurance. The average cost per student is \$21.00 and **is included in the registration fee.**

**PowerSchool:** PowerSchool is the school management program that allows family access to daily attendance, daily grades and assignments, progress report and report card grades. This annual cost is \$30 per student, which covers the yearly school fee paid by HCCA and **is included in the registration fee.**

**Harrington Consortium:** Because Holy Cross Catholic Academy's library is a member of the Harrington Consortium, our card holders can use all the services of other members and have access to all available materials. The cost is approximately \$25.00 per student and **is included in the registration fee.**

**Athletic Fees:** The athletic fees are used for coaching stipends, transportation, athletic director stipend, officials, facilities, etc. The athletic fee for each sport is **to be paid in full before the first scheduled game, tournament or meet.**

**Senior Graduation Fee:** The graduation fee of \$125.00 is for seniors only and covers the cost of the graduation expenses, the diploma and cover, and cap and gown. The fee does not cover the cost of senior rings and graduation invitations. **Payment for this fee is due by March 1<sup>st</sup>.**

**Fundraising:** The fundraising fee is **\$1000 per family**. If a family fails to earn the required \$1000 with fundraising, the balance is added to the family's FACTS account. A family may decide to pay \$1000 in August, 2 payments of \$500 in August and January or pay monthly through FACTS.

**Service Hours:** The tuition does not begin to cover the total cost of educating each student. Service hours are a necessary and integral part of keeping tuition at a reasonable level and keeping the school operating within its budget. Each family is required to work 30 hours at \$25.00 per hour. If registration is paid in full before April 15<sup>th</sup> and tuition contract signed, the number of required service hours will be reduced to 15 hours. Each un-worked hour will be billed at \$25.00 per hour and due on the last statement for the school year.

**Tuition:** The tuition is the same for all students. There is an \$800.00 Deanery Scholarship for each Catholic student whose family is a registered and active member of a parish. A completed verification of registration form is required to receive this scholarship. There are tuition discounts for multiple-student families. Monthly, quarterly, and bi-annual tuition payments are paid through FACTS, an online tuition-collecting program. **There is a yearly fee of \$45.00 payable to FACTS with finalization and activation in May.**

There is a limited amount of funds available and it is given on a first come, most needed basis. **There is a one-time \$30.00 fee for the application payable to FACTS.**
